  - PMU Registry & Other core services



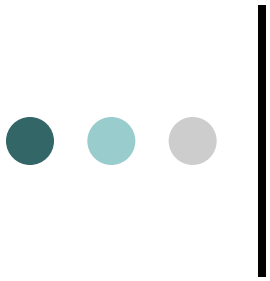
