3. Update on other activities – Standing Topics:

- PMU Standards
  - C37.242 (Allen Goldstein); entire standard revised with exception of final annex, taskforce headed by Jay Murphy to revise annex, then will done and ready for working group review.
  - C37.118.2 (Vasudev Gharpure); work is progressing, second round of reviews, trimmed own to what actually want to implement, had call yesterday, second round document completed by end of month, then begin modifying the documents, need thorough review by contact working group members, document dissemination, some hiccups but things will get better.

- PDC Standards
  - PC37.247-C19 (Vasudev Gharpure); second recirculation ballot in December, passed without comments, meeting later, but should pass or get released later this year.
- IEEE PES PSRC C23 (Mahendra Patel) meeting to go over current activity, Allen not aware of any NASPI 'asks' right now, Bill Dickerson continues with his outreach activity. In May, IEEE PES international conference at Texas A&M, conference (May 20-23 2019), ask Jeff Dagle to mention conference perhaps during the slide rotation during the NASPI Work Group meeting.
- IEEE ICAP/NIST (Allen Goldstein/ Ravi Subramaniam) another major PMU vendor getting ready for certification in ICAP, new draft of test specification, needs steering committee vote.
- IEEE PE/PSCC P2664 Standard for Streaming Telemetry Transport Protocol (Ken Martin) met at last meeting and approved an outline, next step is to have Ritchie and Ken do a first draft rather than have individuals put pieces together, still waiting to get started, EPG doing quite a bit of development to what they produce, need to know how protocol is going to work.
- GMLC Update Tom Rizy; initial release is supposed to be next month.
