# **DisTT**

- o Review of DisTT Goals and Action Plan.
- O DisTT would like to build on a set of use case papers; set of five are due for expansion or revisions. Another seven described in last year's white paper are waiting volunteers. We want to expand the scope of synchronized measurements; time synchronized magnitude and point-on-wave data. Identify most important near-term impact. New possibility for use cases listed in the action plan.
- We like to ask other Operators about the use cases and applications which would provide most and timely value.
- o Draft Operator Questions for Discovery of concerns to real-time operations.
- O Dan likes the white paper DisTT has done in the past and sees an opportunity for expansion to produce a product that is useful to the control room operators and not necessarily academic in nature. For example gathering feedback on questions such as; knowing what fire risk mitigation strategies are employed by your utility?

- ✓ We'd like to get some volunteers to take these questions to the control room and get feedback from the operators?
- ✓ Panos asserted he is doing work for a Swiss company, preparing a distribution grid survey to evaluate the status of existing technologies used in the utilities and to analyze the use of intelligent systems for monitoring, control, management, and digitization of distribution grids. The survey will be sent out to France, Germany, Switzerland, and Italy. Panos should be able to share the "Green Data" with the DisTT.
